Theoretical papers explicitly dealing with experimental/behavioral issues are also welcome. The conference is held in English.

The conference will feature two opening lectures by **Ariel Rubinstein** (NYU and Tel Aviv University) and **Drazen Prelec** (MIT).

We are pleased to announce that a special issue of the *Revue Economique* will gather papers presented at the conference. The call for papers will be distributed during the conference.

Please also note that the ASFEE creates its **prize for the best paper presented by a young economist**, granted to a conference speaker aged no more than 33 years. The winner will be offered the possibility to publish the paper as a regular article in Theory and Decision.
